


GrowABrain in association with Lee Street Studios Presents:

The **Information Revelation** is an exhibition showcasing the latest work by UK artist and illustrator Russell Hardman at **Lee Street Studios** from **21**st-**24**th **July 2011**.

Representing **GrowABrain** Russell will be exhibiting upholstered printed vinyl canvases (volumenbilder), various prints, silkscreened t-shirts and large format paintings, the largest of which, the 6 x 9 foot *'Ancient Confessions'*, took 6 months to complete.

This past year Russell has been working extensively with the band **Dodgy** since their reunion tour, producing illustrations, t-shirts, posters and also working on art for their upcoming album, 'Stand Upright in a Cool Place' released January 2012.

Letter from psychedelic artist Abe Gurvin:

Hey Russell, Intrepid Voyageur, Cultural Savage, Fellow Sojourner Into The Nether Worlds, Explorer of the Phantasmical, and Kindred Spirit. Your artwork, full of lucidly liberating visual iconography and earnestly iconoclastic imagery is a Delight. It's sheer holographic quantum gravity ranks it up there on my pantheon. A refreshing blast of hyperventilated Rx antidote to blast through the mundane matrix of Illusion. You are The Real Deal and my advice is worth just what it cost, but I'll give it to you straight anyhow: "KEEP IT UP, whatever the hell it is you are reaching toward and wheresoever this wild ride may take you." I would add to fear not serendipitous sidetracks and foolhardy and anguished diversions, all of my demi-gods and goddesses have clay feet and abound with such, whether it be the potpourri of groups represented in the Rhino Nuggets collection or Janis Joplin, or say the rapturously spellbinding Jimi Hendrix or the visionary mind-expanding sacreligious ramblings of John Lennon, Terrence McKenna, R.Crumb and even Carlos Castaneda (of fact or fiction). They all were pioneers and transformational trailblazers into the infinite, expanding the doors of perception, and contributed to assisting us mere mortals to break through and emerge beyond the dark Platonic shadow worlds to Places of Heart, Soul and Substance and you too often get there in your chasen craft

Do check in now and then, push the boundaries of what was thought possible, and share your Vision.


